Glucksberg, 521 U.S. 702 (1997), the constitution and more specifically, the due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment, protects the fundamental rights of parents to direct the care, upbringing, and educations of their children.

Nearly one hundred years ago, the Supreme Court acknowledged that "the child is not the mere creature of the State: those who nurture him and direct his destiny have the right, couple with the high duty, to recognize and prepare him for additional obligations."

From Pierce v. Society of Sisters, 268 U.S. 510 (1925). Also, the Supreme Court affirmed the fundamental rights of parents "in companionship, care, custody, and management" of their children, from Stanley v. Illinois, 405 U.S. 645 (1972)

The same year, in Wisconsin v. Yoder, 406 U.S. 205 (1972), the Court declared that "[t]his primary role of the parents in the upbringing of their children is now established beyond debate as an enduring American tradition."

So, I repeat myself: Parents are legally, emotionally and financially responsible for the lives of their children. Let the school share in the entirety of what is transpiring at the school, from social emotional learning to gender issues.
